SAINTS SPLIT THE WEEK

The final week of the regular season started with a bang. On Wednesday night,, Saints starting pitcher, Collin Krick, trotted out to the mound to face off with the Montrose-Waverly Stingers. About an hour and a half later, he would be mobbed by his teammates.

11 runs of offense would be plenty for Krick as he dazzled the Stingers, tossing just 59 pitches en route to the 4th no-hitter in D-C Saints history. He joins Dave Gasta, Perry Thinesen, and Darren Bruss, and is the first Saint to complete the feat since 1998.

At the plate, five separate Saints would have multi-hit games, led by Dylan Weber who was 2-4 with a double, 3 RBI, and a walk.

On Sunday, the Saints couldn't quite capture the magic from Wednesday night. Facing off with the Maple Plain Diamond Devils in a game to decide the #7 seed in the Region 12C tournament, the visiting Devils would find a way to scratch 3 runs and shut out the Saints.

Jordan Flick started on the mound, pitching 8 innings and giving up just one earned run. Jacob Niemela pitched a scoreless 9th.

The bats were cold, collecting just 3 hits off Maple Plain starter, Kyle Bode, who threw 8 1/3 innings of shutout baseball before handing it off to Gunnar Goodwin to make the final two outs and earn the save.
